Ann Maury, 98, of Allentown, formerly of Waverly, NY died October 21, 2021 in Mosser Nursing Home, Trexlertown. She was the wife of Richard H. Maury. They were married for 77 years last December. Born in Allentown, she was the daughter of the late Charles H. and Lillian E. (Hensinger) Nagle. After graduation from Allentown High School in 1939, Ann worked in the office and was an operator at Bell Telephone prior to her marriage. When the family moved back to Allentown, she volunteered at the American Red Cross and was a receptionist at Phoebe Terrace for several years. She was also a former member of the Valley United Presbyterian Church, Waverly where she taught Sunday school and sang on the choir.
