Carol Marie Wolf Huber, 93, died peacefully in her home on June 13, 2024.

She was born in Milwaukee, Wisconsin, on April 29, 1931, the daughter of the late Roman Paul Wolf and Alma Wagner Wolf. As a child, she attended Eldershade School near Beaver Dam, WI, where she discovered her love of education.

She graduated from Beaver Dam High School in 1949. She attended Wayland Junior College for one year before transferring to Columbia County Normal School to become a one-room-school teacher. Her first teaching job was at Jefferson-Beaver Dam & Trenton #2 School.

On August 8, 1953, she married the love of her life, the late 1st Lieutenant Carl Joseph Huber at St. Peter's Roman Catholic Church in Beaver Dam, WI. Together they lived at Fort Bragg, NC, before returning to Wisconsin to live in Kiel and Denmark. By the 1970s, they and their five children lived in Marshfield, WI.

Both Carol and Carl loved to travel and they went on to live in Stockton, CA; Danville, KY; and Allentown, PA. Throughout, Carol continued to work as a substitute teacher. In Allentown, she and Carl were both very active with St. Thomas More Parish, Allentown Central Catholic High School, and the

Pennsylvania Shakespeare Festival.

Carol was an avid reader and a caring mother, grandmother, and great grandmother. She had a whimsical sense of humor and was devoted to her family.
