Doris A. Todd, 75, of Upper Macungie Twp., passed away on October 15, 2024 in Complete Care at Lehigh in Macungie. She was the loving wife of Ralph S. Todd. They were married for 51 years in May. Doris was a special education teacher and a kindergarten teacher at multiple schools in the Allentown School District, retiring in 2006. During her career, she received the Outstanding Teacher of the Year Award. Doris was a 1967 graduate of Allentown High School and in 1971 she obtained her Master's Degree in Special Education from Kutztown University. She served the Ecumenical Food Bank for many years, was a former board member of City Space Day Care, was a member of the Allentown Art Museum and was member of the Daughters of the American Revolution Liberty Bell Chapter. She was a member of St. John's United Church of Christ, Allentown. At the church, Doris was a former Sunday School Teacher, served on the Board of Christian Education and was a member of the Church Consistory. Doris loved her family; they were her top priority, and she saw the good in her own children. She enjoyed knitting and counted cross stitch.
