



## Gertrude "Midge" Peischl

Gertrude "Midge" Peischl (nee Gerress), aged 88, died peacefully at Holy Family Manor in Bethlehem Saturday, May 16, 2020. Midge was born in Pittsburgh and grew up in Philadelphia and Quakertown. She was the daughter of the late Stefan Gerress and the late Katherine Gerress (nee Mueller). She was married to the late Alfred Peischl of Allentown in St. Isidore's Roman Catholic Church in Quakertown on October 27, 1956, after which she and Al settled in Allentown and raised their family of five children. 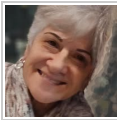
# Tribute Wall
