Harvey John Klase, Jr, 95, formerly of Orefield, passed away November 1, 2022 in Fellowship Manor, Whitehall. He was the loving husband of Sue Mary (Everett) Klase, to whom he was married for 58 years, before her passing in 2006. Harvey was an accountant/cost analyst at PPL Corporation in Allentown until retiring in 1990, having started there as an elevator operator. Born in Allentown, on November 12, 1926, he was the son of the late Harvey John Klase, Sr. and the late Edna Serena (Wolf) Klase. He proudly served his country as a Yeoman Third Class in the US Navy during WWII. Harvey was a longtime member of Bethel and then Cedar Crest Bible Fellowship Church, Allentown.

Harvey trusted in Jesus Christ at a young age and walked with the Lord the rest of his life, committing himself to serving the Lord by giving his time, humor, and resources to his family, many friends, and church.
