Joseph Marrongelle, the long-time resident and active member of the community of Allentown, PA, died peacefully on February 27, 2024, at the age of 87. Joseph is survived by his loving wife, Angela Marrongelle; son Kevin Marrongelle (fiancée Noelle Upah), daughter Karen Marrongelle (husband Brian Hopkins) and beloved granddaughter Vivienne Hopkins.

Joseph was born in Reading, PA on January 30, 1937, where he grew up with an extended Italian-American family. He was the only child of Bertha and Rocco Marrongelle. He graduated from Reading High School in 1955 and studied Business Administration at the University of Pennsylvania Wharton School. Joseph served in the PA National Guard, Air Force Division. He graduated from the American Institute of Insurance and spent his 58-year career practicing life, property and casualty insurance in eastern PA - Reading, Warrington, Scranton, and throughout the Lehigh Valley. He also served a brief stint in Seattle, WA. He held various leadership roles in professional insurance organizations, including President of the Pennsylvania State Independent Insurance Agents of America and Director of the Professional Insurance Agents of Pennsylvania.

He gave generously of his time and talent throughout the years. He served as President of the Allentown Jaycees, President of Big Brothers of Lehigh County and was an involved member of St. Thomas More Catholic Church,

where he served as a School Board Member, Eucharistic Minister, and Vice President of Prime Time social group. He held various leadership roles in Catholic Charities. He was a Fourth-Degree member of the Knights of Columbus.

An avid sports fan and news aficionado, he rooted first for his beloved New York Giants and Yankees. Joseph enjoyed watching sports throughout the year and reading daily newspapers – oftentimes eight papers per day!

A Mass of Christian Burial will be held on Saturday, March 2, 2024 at 11 A.M. in St. Thomas More Catholic Church 1040 Flexer Ave. Allentown. A Calling Hour will be held on Saturday, from 10 A.M. to 11 A.M. in the Church.
