Kasey (Kay Ann Wells) Renowden, 78, passed away on 10/6/2024. She is survived by husband Joe, daughters Julianne and Deborah, and many much loved family and friends. Kasey was born in Hillsdale, Michigan, on November 30, 1945, to Cpl. Franz F. Wells US Army Air Corps and Claramae (Wolf) Wells. She grew up in northeastern Indiana and graduated from Fremont High

School, Fremont, IN. She graduated from Olivet College in Olivet, Michigan with a BA in Elementary Education and taught grades 1 to 6.

She married Joseph D. Renowden, a sailor and engineering student at Tri State College in Angola, IN in 1968. They had two daughters, Julianne and Deborah. In 1970 the family moved to Miami, FL. Kasey continued teaching and worked at Girl Scouts of America, both as a troop leader and on the Council. When the family moved to Jupiter, FL, in 1987, Kasey worked in her church office at First United Methodist of Jupiter-Tequesta for many years. The family moved to Bethlehem, PA in 2017, where she attended Wesley Church and participated in the church prayer group and visitation as a Stephen Minister.
