Lucille I. Stephens, 96, of Salisbury Twp., passed away on February 27, 2025 at home. She was the widow of the late architect, E.J. Stephens. Born in Allentown, she was the daughter of the late Oswald and Minnie Mae (Isbell) Seip. Lucille's voice teacher was Bernard Taylor of the Juilliard School of Music in New York City. Before retirement, she was a soloist at the Jackson Heights Community Church in Long Island, NY, the Clarence Dickinson Festival in Brooklyn, NY and many oratorios. Locally, she was a soloist at the former St. James Evangelical Lutheran Church, Allentown. Lucille performed at West Park with the Allentown Pops Orchestra and the Allentown Band. She had leading roles at the Munopco Music Theatre and Civic Little Theatre. In addition to singing, she was a retired cellist of the Allentown Symphony Orchestra. She was a past president of the Allentown Music Club and volunteered for Meals on Wheels and the Good Shepherd Home. Lucille was a member of St. Timothy Evangelical Lutheran Church, Allentown.
