Patrick J. Ferguson, 82, of Macungie, passed away December 27, 2020 in the Lehigh Valley Hospital, Salisbury Twp. He was the loving husband of the late Marian Ann (Maroni) Ferguson. Patrick worked for 34 years at Redner's Markets, retiring as a Vice-President. Born in Dunmore, PA, he was the son of the late Martin and Anna (Lynott) Ferguson and step-son of the late Kathleen Ferguson.
