Raymonde A. Brensinger passed away peacefully at Legacy Place Cottages December 27, 2020. The widow of Donald E. Brensinger, she was a member of the Macungie congregation of Jehovah's Witnesses. Born in Paris in 1927, she experienced the challenges of wartime Europe. Then Don entered her life, bringing love and security. They married in Paris in early 1946 and Don brought his beautiful petite bride back home to Allentown, PA. Their neighbor Mabel Wagner shared Bible truths and soon they were baptized as Jehovah's Witnesses. They were active ministers and in the early 1960's they moved to Madagascar to help others to learn Bible truth. After several years, they returned to the US, serving in the Bethlehem and Allentown congregations. They retired to Merritt Island, Florida, returning to Legacy Place in late 2014. They were married 69 years. Art helped define Raymonde. A self-taught artist, many of her paintings reflected Jehovah's creation. Legacy Place is privileged to have many on display. We will all remember the cute little face, the sweet French accent and her big heart.
