Richard H. Maury, 100, of Allentown, formerly of Waverly, NY died February 8, 2022 in Mosser Nursing Home, Trexlertown. He was the husband of the late Ann (Nagle) Maury. They were married for 77 years, prior to her passing. Born in Allentown, he was the son of the late Franklin H. and Theresa A. (Rattler) Maury. A 1937 graduate of Allentown High School, Richard began his career at Mack Trucks designing the dark room. He then got leave and served his country in the Air Force during World War II. After the war, he became the chief tool designer at Mack Trucks followed by a position as a product designer at General Electric. Richard was also a teacher for the trade department of the Allentown School District. When he moved his family to New York, he worked as an engineer and taught classes in metrics at Ingersoll Rand, Waverly for 15 years before retiring in 1984. After retirement, he moved his family back to Allentown and worked as a substitute teacher at Lehigh County Technical Institute. He was a member of Hope United Church of Christ, Allentown, a member of the former Salem United Church of Christ, Allentown and a former member of the Valley United Presbyterian Church, Waverly. A talented musician, Richard played the trombone in the church orchestra and eventually became the conductor at Salem United Church of Christ.

Survivors: daughter, Vicki J. wife of Ronald W. Moyer of Germansville; sons, Brett A. Maury and his wife Lydia of Hayward, CA, Kevin R. Maury and his wife Marisa of Shaker Heights, OH; 8 grandchildren; 16 great-grandchildren; 9

great great-grandchildren. Richard was predeceased by his wife, Ann Maury, his daughter, Wendy Marie Maury and his son, Craig H. Maury.
