Sandra McCormack Colon, nee Bundle said Goodbye to friends, family and loved ones on March 4, 2025. Born in 1942, she grew up in Lopez, PA, Sullivan County. She is the daughter of the late Peter and Eleanor (Yudzeky) Bundle. Sandi was a graduate of Turnpike High School, Class of 1960. She went on to Bloomsburg University, graduating in 1963 with a Bachelor Degree in Education. She specialized in Special Education and also teaching the gifted child. She earned a minor in psychology. She began her teaching career in Anne Arundel County, Maryland and was a Vice-Principal before leaving to raise her children. During this time, Sandra worked with Seminarians and Nuns from the Diocese of Baltimore to help write a program for children with disabilities to receive the sacrament of Communion. In 1972, she moved to the Lehigh Valley. During this time she was a den mother for the Boy Scouts and was also elected as the first female President of the Shepherd Hills H.O. Assoc. In 1977, she began a new career with ASH Hospital, now the Lehigh Valley Hospital Health Network and served as the Manager of Patient Financial Services, retiring in 2008. Sandra won numerous awards during her career, including being acknowledged in the National Register's Who's Who in Executives and Professionals in 2003. Sandra loved dancing and parties. She attended the Symphony Balls in Allentown and was active in the Nite Lites at Lehigh Valley Hospital. She enjoyed playing golf and loved tennis and traveling. Sandra was a member of St. Thomas More Catholic Church, Allentown.

Survivors: Son, Todd McCormack; Daughter, Toni (Robert); Grandsons, Chason and Trent, and a Sister, Sharon Hartnett. She was predeceased by a Daughter, Kelly Ann and her Husband, Edward Colon.
