Sharon Bates, 67, of Wescosville, passed away with her family by her side on January 24th, in the comfort of her home after a long battle with a rare neurological disease. She was a natural homemaker and mother. She was known for her skills in baking and gardening. She administered the home front with the finesse and commitment that a military general would envy, combined with a gentleness and smile that made everyone feel welcome. She also had a wide scope of volunteer roles at Lehigh Valley Hospital, Phoebe Home, Meals on Wheels, Dough to Door and many others.

In her free time, she played tennis most often at the West End Racquet Club. She was a gifted athlete and had a full schedule of league matches where she

was voted as the most aggressive player by her team. When she wasn't playing tennis, you could find her and Jack on the dance floor swing dancing.

She and Jack were known for their hospitality and strong partnership; they hosted many small group Bible studies and neighborhood parties over the years. Sharon was also a gifted speaker in many women's groups and Bible studies. Her life was lived with purpose, and she will be sorely missed.
