William A. Madden died on January 16, 2020 at Lehigh Valley Hospital Cedar Crest, surrounded by his family. Born in Ashland, PA December 6, 1938 he was the husband of Alice E. (Lasser) Madden for 57 years. He was the son of the late Martin J. Madden and Catherine (Reilly) Madden. He attended St. Joseph High School, graduating in 1956. He and his twin brother Thomas entered the United States Navy in June 1956 and served aboard the USS Galveston and USS Iowa. Bill and Tom were plank owners on the USS Galveston.
